<p>If any <b>staff / client / student / vendor</b> answers <b>YES</b> to any of the screening questions, they will not be permitted to enter the facility and be directed to complete the <a href="#">AHS online assessment tool for staff</a> to determine if they require testing.</p> <p>Note: If you have a <b>fever, cough, shortness of breath, runny nose</b> or <b>sore throat</b>, you are <u>legally required</u> to isolate for <u>at least 10 days</u> from the start of your symptoms or until they resolve, whichever is longer.</p> <p>The only exception to staff being screened is in the case of an emergency where the stopping to be screened would negatively affect the reason for their entry (fire, police, medical emergency).</p>
